# Crafter Application

Welcome to the 41st Annual Harvestfest in York Beach, Maine

*Please be sure to read all information carefully. Incomplete applications will not be accepted*

- Harvestfest will be a **one-day event** on Saturday, October 17. The event will be held from **9:00am to 4:00pm**.
- Railroad Avenue will remain open to one lane of traffic with police-manned pedestrian crossings throughout the festival.
- **Parking:** York's Wild Kingdom is again donating the use of their parking lots during the event providing easy access for festival-goers. You will also be free to park at Ellis Park for free (as it will be after October 15)
- **This is a rain or shine event.**
- Juried craft vendors are not able to drive on the ball field for set-up. Please plan ahead to transport your products onto the field and parking lot with carts or dollies.
- **Early check-in/set-up:** The Friday prior to the event, you may do early check-in from **1:00 pm to 4:00pm**. Please do not arrive before 1:00 pm. All vendors must be completely setup and ready to leave the event grounds by 4:00pm. (No Exceptions)
- **Regular Check-in:** The morning of the event at **6:00 am**. No one may be on the ball field or Wild Kingdom prior to that. *When arriving via Railroad Avenue, stay in the left lane.*
- **Booth spaces cannot be shared by businesses.**
- **No soliciting or surveying** by any political, religious or other special cause groups or individuals is permitted.
- **Vendor Cancellations:** **Booth fees are non-refundable. If the event is postponed, any vendor payments will be honored for the rescheduled date, no exceptions.**
- **Juried vendors** (handmade crafts) will be located in the York Beach ball field.
- **Old Fashioned Market** vendors (buy/sell products) will be located in the parking lot across from the York Beach fire station and adjacent to the entrance to York's Wild Kingdom on the pavement.

Please review the [Harvestfest Vendor Map](#) and select your preferred sites. Enter the numbers on the enclosed application and mail it back to us ASAP with your check or credit card account information.

**The spaces will be awarded on a first come/first served basis.  
Past participation does not guarantee a booth spot.**

## **JURIED CRAFTERS: On the ball field**

Products juried by selection committee. Acceptance is based on originality, creativity, general appeal and quality of craft and booth design. Purchase of a booth space does **not** guarantee exclusivity of your product type.

### **Types of products accepted:**

Art, craft and hobby work items of original design and completely handcrafted by YOU.

Pre-packaged food items made in a licensed kitchen by the vendor (ex: dips, candy, sauces, etc)

**No manufactured or imported items are allowed. This will be strictly enforced.**

*Vendors who did not participate last year or whose products have changed: 4 photographs must be submitted including one of your work space/studio.*

## **OLD FASHIONED MARKET: In paved lot at the zoo entrance, across from the fire station**

Open to all products with Chamber approval. Can re-sell products in this section. No “novelty items” as listed below.

The following “novelty items” will not be allowed at the festival:

Noise-makers; clackers; fire-crackers; cap-shooters; knives, swords or guns of ANY kind; lighters; ANYTHING that shocks. This is a no tolerance policy: if a staff member sees any of these types of items, you will leave the festival immediately with no refund.

The committee has the right to refuse any vendor or limit the number of vendors based on product category such as jewelry, photography, pottery, etc.

*Vendors who did not participate last year or whose products have changed: 4 photographs must be submitted*

## **RULES FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS:**

- Spaces are approximately 10' x 10'. **Tents and displays must be located entirely within the assigned space.** You will need to supply ALL needed supplies for your space including tents, tables, chairs, etc. **We reserve the right to relocate and reassign spaces without notice** although we will make every effort to accommodate requests. **Electricity is NOT available for craft vendors, no generators are allowed and no cooking is allowed in Juried or Old Fashioned Market.**
- **All tents, merchandise and personal belongings left overnight are at your own risk. We do not patrol the area. Harvestfest and the Chamber of Commerce accepts no responsibility for items lost, stolen or damaged.**
- **Tents must be adaptable to lawn or hard-topped surfaces and equipped with weights and stakes in case of wind. Harvestfest and the Chamber of Commerce accepts no responsibility for items lost, stolen or damaged.**
- We reserve the right to deny participation to vendors whose merchandise is deemed inappropriate and not in keeping with the theme. See the list above for a sample list of unacceptable products.
- No commercial carts, trucks, etc. are allowed at Harvestfest.
- No beverages may be sold & each pre-packaged food item must be pre-approved for sale. **Selling food items of any kind like packaged candy, herb dips, bbq sauce, etc. require the vendor to provide a certificate of insurance listing York Region Chamber of Commerce as additional insured as well as all applicable State Licenses**
- Harvestfest is a smoke-free, dog-free and balloon-free festival and we ask everyone to comply with this, including vendors.
- The Chamber Harvestfest Committee makes the final decision about ALL products being sold.
- All applications must include the license plate number for the vehicle that you will have at the festival. Only one vehicle will receive a parking pass. Other vehicles may assist vendor unloading, but must unload, and immediately move vehicle. **Vehicles parked in the loading areas once the event starts will be towed at owners expense.**
- Vendors are permitted to leave boxes, paper or food in the dumpster located next to the ball field in the parking area. **The trash cans are not to be used for vendor trash.** Your booth will be inspected after you leave the event.
- The Town of York has prohibits single-use carry out plastic bags provided by retailers at checkout throughout York. Please have either reusable or paper bags for your customers.
